The recurring theme of this Kathy Hodge–designed bathroom is glass: on the walls, in the shower, over the mirrors, in the cabinetry. Early in the design process, Hodge and her client decided to use the bright light of nearby Long Island Sound to their advantage, reflecting the scenic brilliance throughout the space with four identical mirrors—two of which are recessed medicine cabinets—and custom-painted gray-back glass. “You feel like you’re partly in the ocean,” says Hodge. “It all feels so natural.” A shade from Conrad Shades adorns the single window, adding subtle texture to the room and serving as a continuation of the light, airy atmosphere.
